The present bibliographical list is a continuation of HENDRICKX, S., *Analytical Bibliography of the Prehistory and the Early Dynastic Period of Egypt and Northern Sudan*. Egyptian Prehistory Monographs 1, Leuven, 1995. Previous additions have been published yearly in *Archéo-Nil* since 1996. The numbering is continued from the original volume and the previous additions. Encyclopaedic works and small notes relating to recent archaeological activities have been treated as separate entries, which of course enlarges the corpus considerably, but proved to be useful with regard to the site register.
